



RECYCLING GUIDE- HOW TO SEND IN MEDALS Updated 5/26/2020

- Send in any sport or academic medals made of metal. We can also take all-metal cups/plates.
- Leave on any ribbons, paper holders, bubble wrap or plastic bags.
- Cardboard boxes are best for mailing. Plastic or bubble mailer envelopes are not recyclable.
- We recommend USPS Flat rate boxes as the most economic form of shipping, as the boxes are one flat rate up to 70 pounds. These boxes are available at your local post office or can be ordered for free online. Securely tape boxes shut so the weight of the medals doesn't break the boxes. Use bubble wrap, newspaper, packing paper or cardboard for support/insulation.
- Save on shipping- collect medals from your club, gym or friends and send them together!

Do not send in any of the following items- these will be thrown out:

- Trophies or plaques of any kind
- Medals that are NOT made of metal- such as plastic, foam, ceramic, acrylics, or wood
- Medals that have water, mold, fire, smoke, or pet damage or stains
- Styrofoam or packaging peanuts- they get destroyed by the weight of the medals
- Ribbons that do not have a medal attached to them- if they are the thin rectangular ribbons (often with small piece of cardboard or paper on the back for writing in statistics) or they are the large horse jumping or swimming ribbons that may have a pinned on symbol in the center- these are actually NOT recyclable.
